Four proposals were received for the READ Clinic. The HSCMG reviewed the proposals and provided their recommendation to the Consortium Board. The Board concurred with their recommendation to provide the space to UW-L’s Recreation Management and Therapeutic Recreation Program. If all goes well, they are looking at a fall 2009 move in date.

In addition, the HSCMG is working on finding alternate solutions to accommodate the needs of the other proposals.
