

Community Based Residential Facility (Alzheimers and Dementia Care)

Setting:

- Home-like alternative to a nursing home
- Increased nursing hours on site
- Licensed staff on duty and awake 24/7
- Redirection
- Secured environment
- Scheduled activities and outings
- Staff trained in dementia care
- Structured activities
- Usually offers individually lockable private rooms

Clientele:

- Accept activated POA, guardianships, and protective placements
- Advanced age
- Advanced dementia
- Assessments determine eligibility for admission

Provide/contract services:

Basic services include:

- Meals (3 meals a day, snacks and refreshments)
- Laundry (linens and personal)
- Housekeeping (daily tidies and deep cleaning)

Specialized services could include, but not limited to:

- Assistance with respiratory equipment, oxygen, CPAP, nebulizer, etc.
- Basic wound care
- Full assistance with ADLs (dressing, bathing, grooming etc.)
- Full assistance with ambulation, mobility, wheelchair
- Moderate to late stage dementia care
- Hospice
- Incontinence care (bowel, bladder, catheter care)
- Palliative Care
- Specialized diets / modified food textures
- Therapy Services
- Two person transfer/hoyer lift assistance

Limitations:

- Prior to admission an assessment of
 - Needs
 - Abilities
 - Physical condition
 - Mental condition
- Emergency admission
 - Above assessment conducted within 5 days after admission
- Within 90 days before or 7 days after admission, each person screened for clinically apparent communicable disease, including tuberculosis

- Generally limited on amount of individuals needing more than 3 hours of nursing care per week

If more care is needed, suggest skilled nursing facility.

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
