What Does Being an Adjunct Nursing Clinical Instructor Entail?

La Crosse Medical Health Science Consortium (LMHSC) Collaboration

The LMHSC's mission is "Fostering collaboration for healthier communities." The LMHSC is a collaborative effort founded by: Gundersen Health System, Mayo Clinic Health System - Franciscan Healthcare, University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, Viterbo University, and Western Technical College. In addition, community partnerships have been strengthened through various LMHSC projects. Many of these projects focus on education/healthcare collaborations.

Viterbo University, Western Technical College and Winona State University have developed a partnership to create an adjunct nursing faculty pool. Adjunct definition

An adjunct faculty person is hired on a contractual basis to teach a specific course for a specified amount of time (partial or full semesters). Contracts are issued on a semester/year basis and are not guaranteed from one semester/year to the next.

General requirements for hire

- Education:
 - Viterbo University: Masters in Nursing (MSN) or currently enrolled & maintained enrollment in MSN
 - Western Technical College: MSN or currently enrolled & maintained enrollment in MSN
 - Winona State University: MSN or enrolled in MSN preferred, Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) considered
- RN license in good standing
 - o Viterbo University: WI required; MN required if clinical in MN
 - Western Technical College: WI RN license or compact state
 - o Winona State University: MN required; WI required if clinical in WI
- Minimum experience of two years as a practicing RN
- Background check
- CPR, immunizations, etc.

***Please note: if applying for a lab technician or simulation lab adjunct position one will need a RN license, but may not need a MSN.
